

Responsive Reading Hebrews 12:1-13

Leader: "Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us.

Congregation: Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us, keeping our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.

L: For the joy that lay before him, he endured the cross, despising the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

C: For consider him who endured such hostility from sinners against himself, so that you won't grow weary and give up.

L: In struggling against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. And you have forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons:

C: My son, do not take the Lord's discipline lightly or lose heart when you are reprovved by him, for the Lord disciplines the one he loves and punishes every son he receives.

L: Endure suffering as discipline: God is dealing with you as sons. For what son is there that a father does not discipline?

C: But if you are without discipline—which all receive—then you are illegitimate children and not sons.

L: Furthermore, we had human fathers discipline us, and we respected them. Shouldn't we submit even more to the Father of spirits and live?

C: For they disciplined us for a short time based on what seemed good to them, but he does it for our benefit, so that we can share his holiness.

L: No discipline seems enjoyable at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

ALL: Therefore, strengthen your tired hands and weakened knees, and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be turned aside but healed instead."
