Shoebox Gift Suggestions

Personal Care Items

Comb, hairbrush, toothbrush, washcloth, bar soap, adhesive bandages, nail clipper and file, stick deodorant, blanket, reusable plastic containers, flashlight (solar-powered or hand-crank; if battery operated be sure in include extra batteries).

Clothing and Accessories

Shirts & pants, pillowcase dress, underwear, shoes and socks, flip-flops, hats/scarf/mittens, sunglasses, tote bag/purse, hair bows, friendship bracelets.

School Supplies

Pencils, small manual pencil sharpener, colored pencils, pencil case, crayons, markers, pens, coloring pads, coloring books, picture book, notebooks, glue stick, playdough, stickers, solar-powered calculator, safety (blunt tip) scissors, ruler, blank index cards, protractor.


Crafts and Activities

RAISE THE ROOF FUND - The flat roof of the church has been leaking and the gutters and downspouts aren't working to keep the water away from the foundation causing damage to the upstairs and basement. The Facilities Maintenance Team requested, and the Administrative Board approved replacing the roofing and re-working the gutters and downspouts before winter. The work has begun, and the cost will be about \$34,000.00. The Administrative Board voted to create a liability account and will be moving \$35,000 into that account. Our goal is to raise an additional \$5,000 to help cover digging the downspout underneath the parking lot. We want to thank Lakeview Chapel for the generous giving that has been done in the past and would pray that you consider helping us get to our next goal by raising an additional \$5,000 to cover projects that are overdue and if left unattended could become more costly and could possibly lead to hazardous conditions for our church family and visitors.
