Roll the dice.

Make a list of 6 things you'd like to do more often, assign them a number, and then roll the dice. As soon as the kids go to bed, do *that thing* together. Then you can watch Netflix or do something on your own afterwards, too.

We assigned it like this (the last three options are board games).

- 1. Genealogy (we're tracing our family trees on Ancestry.com!)
- 2. Ballroom Dancing
- 3. Take a walk.
- 4. Play Photosynthesis
- 5. Play Tiny Towns
- 6. Play Wingspan

(We're going to add some organizing tasks to the dice—assign different closets/rooms to the numbers and roll the dice and we have to spend 10 minutes organizing before we move on to something fun. But you get the picture: **it can be adapted for whatever you want**.)
